

HOME RULE RESOLUTION NO. HR-2003-_____

A RESOLUTION SETTING A FINE SCHEDULE FOR VIOLATIONS OF COUNTY RESOLUTIONS

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Shawnee, Kansas possesses home rule authority pursuant to K.S.A. 19-101 *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Shawnee, Kansas resolves to exercise its home rule authority to set a fine schedule for the violation of certain Shawnee County resolutions.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Shawnee, Kansas, meeting in regular session this _____ day of July, 2003, and intending to exercise its powers of home rule pursuant to K.S.A. 19-101a, does hereby resolve as follows:

1. The following is a schedule of fines for the violation of the applicable Home Rule Resolution:
