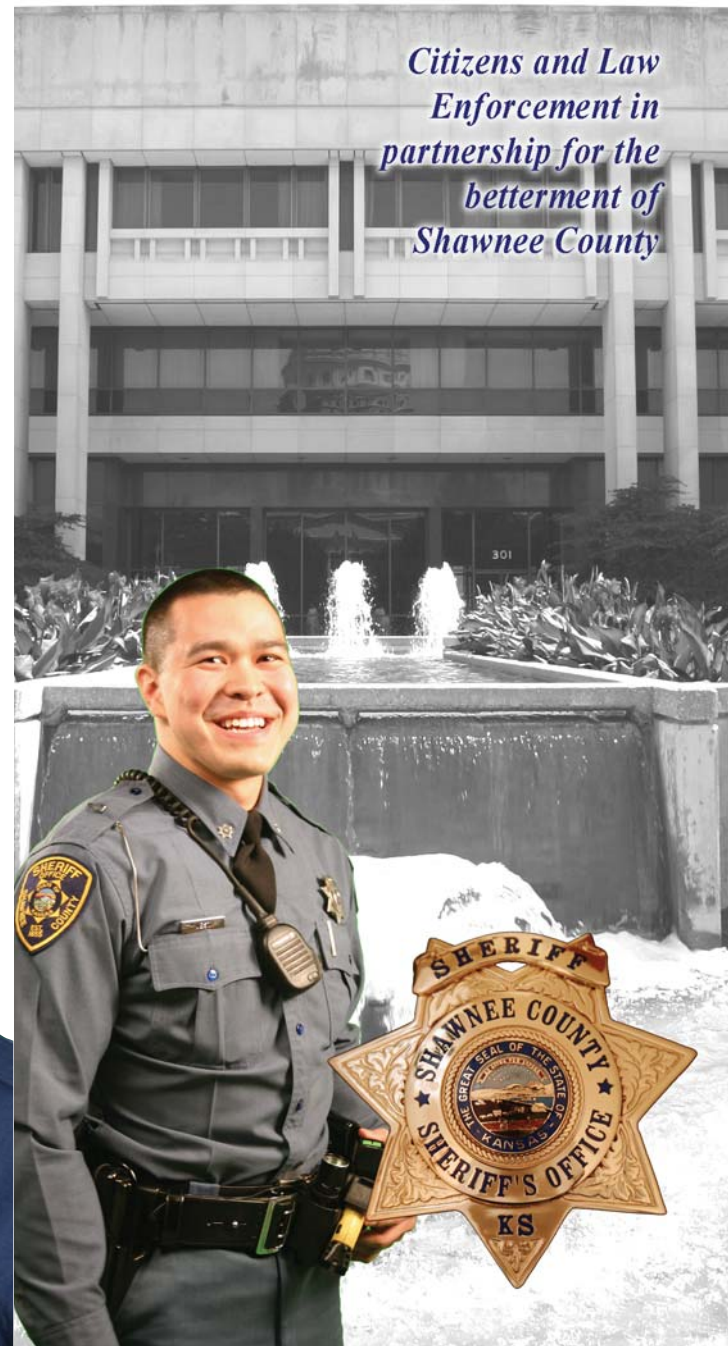
Dear Citizen,

The Shawnee County Sheriff's Office Citizen's Academy is designed to acquaint residents of Topeka and Shawnee County with the goals, objectives, organizational structure, and general operating procedures of the agency and to promote good will, mutual understanding and community support.

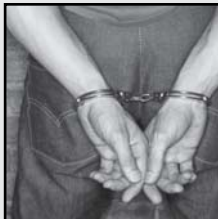
Participation Criteria and Selection

Any resident of Shawnee County who is at least 18 years old, has no criminal record and agrees to the established program rules, may participate in the program. Applicants who meet the criteria for participation will be notified of their course depending upon available course space. Applicants must agree to submit to a background check.

Course Activities and Scheduling

The Citizens Academy will be conducted periodically and will meet one night a week for 13 weeks. Sessions are held at the Law Enforcement Center at 320 S. Kansas. Program topics include overviews of the following:

- Patrol Operations
- Traffic Law Enforcement
- Criminal Investigations
- Narcotics Investigations
