Operation Identification is a system of marking your valuables for positive, permanent identification to discourage thieves. Operation ID helps in identifying stolen property, acts as a deterrent to criminals (marked property is harder to “fence”) and aids in prosecution of suspects found with marked property. This program lets you help in fight against crime.

To obtain an Operation Identification Number, contact the Sheriff's Community Services Division at 368-2217 or 2218.

Tips to keep your home safe from Burglaries.

1. Cut back shrubs, and open up other potential hiding places.
2. Properly placed exterior security lighting such as motion detection lights, sun sensor lights, or street lights, increase visibility at night.
3. Install and always use properly installed security locks.
4. An inventory list is part of home security. Photo all valuable items and record the make, model, and serial number of each item on the back of the photo.
5. Be a good neighbor! Report suspicious behavior.

The Shawnee County Sheriff's Office has prepared this information to help you, as a victim of crime, to understand some of the resources available in our community to assist you. The Kansas Legislature has also recognized the need to give victims of crime a voice and enacted the "Bill of Rights for Victims of Crime" KSA 74-7333 and 74-7335. The basis of this bill is to ensure the fair and compassionate treatment of victims of crime.
